O-means only that she's growing old

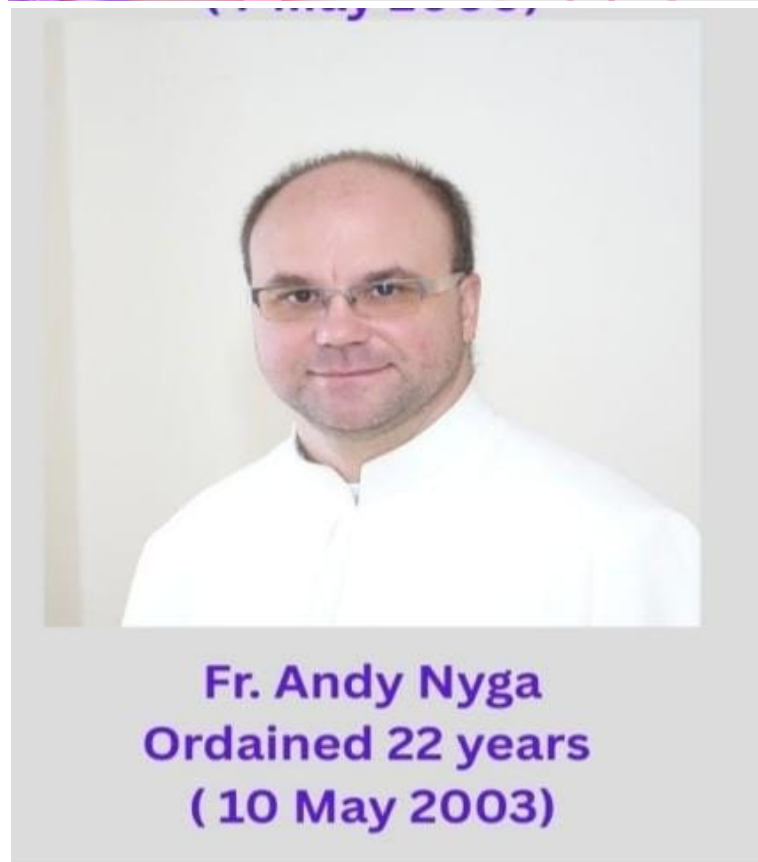
T-is for the tears she shed to save me
